It provides participants with the opportunity to experience the various disciplines of engineering as a possible university course and career option. It is conducted within a highly supportive mentoring framework.

Applications close Monday 9 November 2009.

The highlight of the program is a reception and Awards ceremony by the Governor General - Ms Quentin Bryce AC.

It is hosted on a two year rotational basis by the University of NSW and the University of Newcastle and in 2010 the Summer School is being held at the University of NSW ( Sydney).
