SAA Daily Services between Perth and Johannesburg

Effective 01 September 2009, South African Airways will operate daily services between Perth and Johannesburg giving passengers more opportunity to fly with South African Airways. The schedule services will be as follows: SA281 departure from PER at 2350 arrival into JNB at 0545+1 on Monday- Friday, SA283 departure from PER at 1120 arrival into JNB at 1715 on Saturday and Sunday. The schedule return services will be as follows: SA280 departure from JNB at 2215 arrival into PER at 1325+1 on Monday- Thursday, and Sunday SA282 departure from JNB at 1620 arrival into PER at 0730+1 on Friday and Saturday.



South African Express to start between Johannesburg and Maun

South African Express flights between Johannesburg and Maun are scheduled to begin operating from 1 July 2009 but are currently closed off for sales until a further announcement is made. South African Express is still waiting for the Department Of Transport to review the bilateral agreement with the Botswana government officials.



V Australia and Virgin America sign Interline Agreement

V Australia and Virgin America have signed an Australia-US interline agreement offering seamless

travel on the networks of each carrier and across the trans-Pacific route.

The agreement will allow passengers to purchase a single ticket for travel in the U.S. and Australia on either carrier.

The new interline arrangement went live on 8th June, 2009 for travel from 8th June, 2009. The agreement will allow passengers to enjoy a seamless “Virgin” experience as Virgin America and V Australia share Los Angeles World Airport’s Terminal 3. Both airlines will transfer baggage between connecting flights and to the final destination once passengers arriving on V Australia’s international flight have collected their checked bags and cleared customs. The interline agreement will make it even easier to fly around the world on Virgin Airlines with V Australia to Los Angeles, Virgin America to five cities, Virgin Atlantic US connecting gateways to London. Passengers will later this year be able to earn Velocity points when flying on Virgin America and will also be able to redeem

Velocity points for flights on Virgin America.



Pacific Blue Announces Direct Flights from Hamilton to Australia

Pacific Blue announced that it will operate direct flights from Hamilton to Australia starting September 2009. The carrier will offer six direct flights from Hamilton comprising of three to Sydney and three to Brisbane. Regular lead-in one way fares will start from \$199 for Hamilton – Sydney and from \$299 for Hamilton – Brisbane. Fares are subject to availability.
