

BAR ATTENDANT COURSE (CENTRAL HIGHLANDS)

Looking for part-time or full-time work in a bar, or need to enhance your current bar skills? Then this short course covering basic bar operations is for you! Provides participants with the skills and knowledge required to carry out bar operations in a range of hospitality enterprises. Training offered is practical and industry-relevant, and ideal for anyone whose current employment involves bar and drink service, or people pursuing work in these areas.

What job could training lead to?

Enhances your prospects as a bar attendant.

Am I eligible?

There are no entry requirements.

What will I receive?

On successful completion learners will receive a Statement of Attainment for competencies successfully completed.

Can I go on to further training?

Yes. Successful completion of this course may gain recognition of your studies towards a qualification in hospitality. Depending on your desired outcome, CQ TAFE has a wide range of training pathways that may suit you.

How long will the training take?

Approximately 95 hours of study time will be involved however, the training duration will depend on the electives, study mode selected and previous work/academic history.

Is what I already know taken into account?
