

## PROVIDE RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL

*This short course deals with the skills and knowledge required to satisfy requirements for the responsible service of alcohol. It covers the legal provisions of the relevant liquor legislation and the underpinning reasons for and benefits of responsible service of alcohol reforms.*

### What job could training lead to?

As this course is a legislation requirement for those serving alcohol in their workplace, it is advantageous for those wanting to enter the hospitality industry, including jobs such as bar attendant and other roles associated with the serving of alcohol.

### Am I eligible?

There are no entry requirements.

### What will I receive?

Statement of Attainment for Responsible Service of Alcohol Course from Queensland Liquor Licensing Division.

### Can I go on to further training?

Yes. This course covers a unit from the national training package, so you may receive recognition of this unit towards Certificate II in Hospitality. Depending on your desired outcome, CQ TAFE has a wide range of training pathways that may suit you.

### How long will the training take?

Duration is usually between four to six hours.
