

RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL AND HYGIENE

This short course deals with the skills and knowledge required to satisfy requirements for the responsible service of alcohol. It covers the legal provisions of the relevant liquor legislation and the underpinning reasons for and benefits of responsible service of alcohol reforms. Workplace hygiene is also covered.

What job could training lead to?

As this course is a legislation requirement for those serving alcohol in their workplace, it is advantageous for those wanting to enter the hospitality industry, including jobs such as bar attendant and other roles associated with the serving of alcohol, and food.

Am I eligible?

There are no entry requirements.

What will I receive?

Statement of Attainment for competencies successfully completed.

Can I go on to further training?

Yes. Successful completion of this course may gain recognition of your studies towards Certificate II in Hospitality. Depending on your desired outcome, CQ TAFE has a wide range of training pathways that may suit you.

How long will the training take?

Duration is usually up to twelve hours.
